# GOSUMEC Foundation USA Minutes of the 2nd Quarter Board Meeting

# 1. Opening and Approval of Minutes

- The meeting was called to order by Dr. Sanjay Bindra.
- The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed.
- A motion to approve the minutes was made, seconded, and unanimously passed.

### 2. Governance and Bylaws

• Sanjay proposed amending the Board renewal policy from two-thirds of the Board retiring every two years to **one member rotating off biennially-every 2 years**, unless a suitable replacement is not available.

- It was further agreed that Dr. Sanjay Bindra will continue to serve as Board Chair and Dr. Archana Bindra will remain on the Board, and both Co-Founders will continue in their roles until they voluntarily step down.
- The Board unanimously supported the proposed change.
- Dr. Sheth and Dr. Shahani emphasized the importance of leadership continuity and endorsed retaining the core leadership team (Drs. Bindras and Dr. Sheth).
- Sanjay will draft and circulate the proposed bylaws amendment for formal approval.

#### 3. Conflicts of Interest

- Dr. Sanjay Bindra disclosed potential conflicts due to his roles as Board Chair, spouse of a Board member, and Director at the Foundation for Excellence (FFE).
- Dr. Archana Bindra also disclosed her role as spouse of a Board member.
- No additional conflicts were declared by other members.

#### 4. Communications

- The Board agreed to continue using WhatsApp and email as the primary channels for Board communication.
- Emphasis was placed on maintaining strong Board engagement and attendance, critical for meeting standards set by the **Better Business Bureau** and **Charity Navigator**.

# 5. Endowments and Capital Projects

Sanjay clarified that all scholarships are now disbursed through FFE, ensuring 95% of the donation reaches students, with a 5% administrative fee (compared to 10% for FFE corporate programs).

- Overhead for Rotary-managed scholarships will be kept under 5%, whereas DJST overheads were previously 8–10% for smaller donations.
- Kiron Master is establishing a **merit-based quasi-endowment** in honor of his mother.
- Sanjay explained the distinction between **permanent endowments** (IRS-qualified, restricted use) and **quasi-endowments** (board-directed flexibility).
- The capital project chapter (e.g., Boys' Common Room) is now officially closed, due
  diligence process followed and met IRS standards for international project supervision
  and reporting. The due diligence report will be filed on the website.
- Reminder: IRS regulations require oversight and accountability even after international funds are transferred.

## 6. OT & PT Scholarships

- The Board discussed pausing the Occupational and Physical Therapy scholarships due to limited impact and inefficient administration.
- A consensus was reached to **pause the program**, unless a scalable and auditable partner can be engaged for transparent execution.

## 7. Strategic Vision & Recognition

- The Foundation reaffirmed its goal of full endowment funding by 2030–2032 to ensure perpetual scholarships.
- GOSUMEC Foundation was recently recognized as a Givebutter success story, selected from tens of thousands of nonprofits.
- Sanjay reiterated the importance of **donor stewardship**, encouraging **6–9 personalized contacts per year** per donor to nurture relationships.
- Heena Rajdeo's donor engagement success was highlighted as a model for Board members.

# 8. Events & Outreach

- Southern California Reunion is confirmed for August 30th at the residence of Dr. Kalpana Savla, coordinated by Archana Bindra.
- **New York Mixer:** Heena and Rohit will organize a regional donor event by the end of the year for **10–20 motivated supporters**.
